Selected models will be

required for fittings, from mid April and will need to attend weekend rehearsals starting in May for the lead up to the Awards evening.

Models will be expected to attend rehearsals at the Carterton Events Centre from Tuesday, May 21 to Friday, May 23, and shimmer down the runway wowing the audience with spectacular creations on the Awards evening of Saturday, May 24.

"We are hoping to hear from a large number of potential models, both male and female, ranging from NZ sizes 8 to 16

for the girls, and XS to XL for the guys," says event organiser Robyn Cherry-Campbell.

Models from the last event really enjoyed the experience, and a number have asked to come back and model again.

"I opened the show in 2012 and it was terrifying ... but from the moment I stepped onto the catwalk I couldn't wait to get back out there," says Shannon Hayes, a model from the last TOF Awards.

"I think I was buzzing for about three days afterwards. The atmosphere was just so neat and the crowd was so

amazing," she says.

Catwalk experience is not essential, as selected models will be trained to walk on a runway.

If models are under the age of 18 then the TOF team will require parental/guardian's permission for their involvement.
